## Pleasanton Bond Measure

PUSD Superintendent Rick Rubino highlighted information related to the November school bond. He explained that if the voters approve the bond measure, the proceeds will be used on a number of projects approved by the school board this summer. Additionally, if the bond measure is approved, PUSD will be eligible for another portion of a \$9 Billion State Bond. Amador will potentially benefit from bond measure projects.

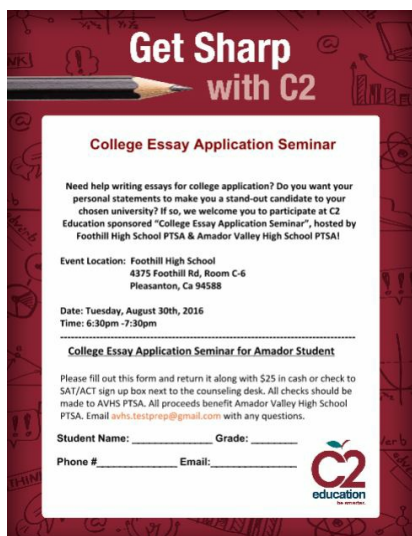
