COUNSELOR ANNOUNCEMENTS:

On **Wednesday, Oct. 19 at 7 p.m.** in Foothill High School's MP, a representative from Saint Mary's College will present on **Financial Aid**. The window for applications has opened early, so come hear about changes and details of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). **Check the Scholarship list on Naviance regularly, and if you find one that needs a school nomination, let your counselor know two weeks before the nomination deadline.**

Also, if you need any **letters of recommendation for private colleges**, see your counselor ASAP as counselors and teachers need at least two weeks to write your letter before you first due date. **December 2 is the deadline for requesting any letters with January due dates!** Counselors can also assist you with transcript request forms.

Seniors: If you are doing any Common Applications for private schools, after you invite your counselor, **you must go see your counselor to submit a Transcript Request Form and discuss your letter of recommendation.** Please be aware that, although you may have requested letters from your teachers, a counselor evaluation is part of your Secondary School Report on Common App. Please **complete your Counselor Questions in Naviance at least two school weeks (10 business days) before your FIRST deadline on Common App.** Thank you!

HALLOWEEN SAFETY:
