Graduation Announcements

Commencement Rehearsal

All Seniors participating in Commencement Exercises are required to attend rehearsal on Friday, June 2, 2017 from 8:00 am to 11:00 am at the Football Stadium.

Commencement Admission Wristbands

Graduation wristbands are required for all guests and will be distributed to each Senior at Student Activities beginning **Tuesday, May 30th**. (*Please note corrected date.*) Each student will receive eight (8) wristbands for the Commencement Program. A valid student ID is required.

All graduation requirements must be met (including service hours) and outstanding bills paid for student to receive wristbands. Wristbands cannot be replaced if lost or damaged.

Commencement

Commencement will be held **Friday, June 2, 2017 at 7:00 pm** at the Football Stadium.

- Students are encouraged, but not required to participate in the ceremony. Seniors must complete the Naviance survey by May 12 to select their diploma presenter.
- Seniors should be ready to line up in front of the library no later than 6:00 pm. The processional will start promptly at 7:00 pm.
- Parents and guests should plan to be seated by 6:45 pm. Please allow adequate time for

parking. Wristbands must be worn and visible. Attendees must remain seated until the ceremony is complete and all graduates have left the field.

- Seniors should leave purses and valuables with relatives or other guests. Dress is semi-formal: no shorts, jeans, flip-flops or tennis shoes. All graduates wear purple gowns which should be ironed before wearing. The mortar board is worn straight on the head with the tassel on the right side.
- Graduates will receive diplomas in the Multipurpose Room following Commencement Exercises.

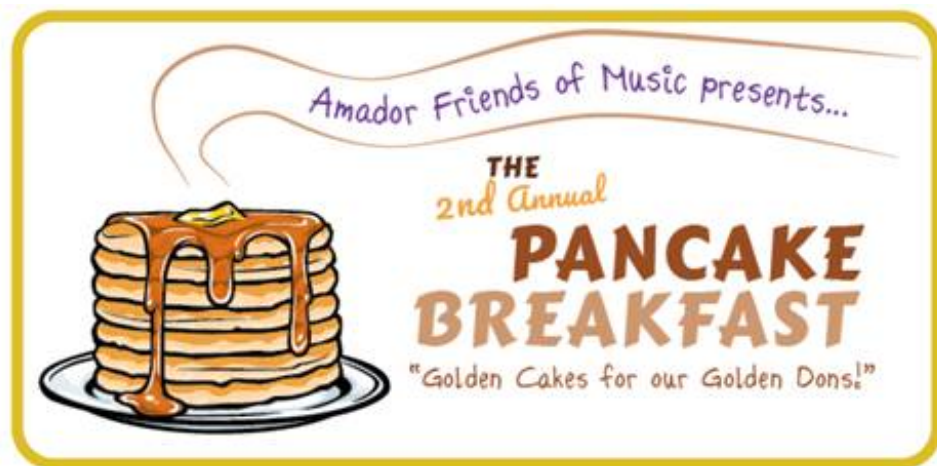
